

SAMPLE IA DAMAGE ASSESSMENT DATA COLLECTION AND SUMMARY FORM

For the purposes of this form, “Individual Assistance” may be thought of as potential assistance to individuals, families, and businesses which is tied to the structures they inhabit. This form is intended for collecting damage assessment data on homes and businesses in the field. It may also be useful for collecting data being provided via “telephone-banks.” The information collected on these forms should be summarized on the IA Street Sheet [\(See FEMA Damage Assessment Operations Manual\)](#)
