The Nevada Division of Emergency Management Supports Transportation Efforts from California for Hurricane Sandy Recovery

Nevada Emergency Operation's staff are working with the California EMA and the Nevada Highway Patrol to support the transport of resources that will be traveling across the state starting today. The Nevada Division of Emergency Management is monitoring the situation on the East Coast and is providing assistance as needed. The Arizona Division of Emergency Management the region's coordinating agency for resources to support the Hurricane Sandy recovery. The three states are in regular communication to insure we are doing all we can to support the states that have been impacted.

On October 29, 2012, 50 utility units began deployment from Davis, California – 20 of those units will be on lowboy trailers. Their destination is Albany, New York. Preliminary routing indicates that these assets will travel through the following states: Nevada, Utah, Wyoming, Nebraska, Iowa, Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, Pennsylvania, and New Jersey. Another 70 units are expected to deploy from various assembly areas in Southern California beginning today; 20 of these units are bound for Rye, New York. The reported route for these assets takes them through Arizona, New Mexico and Texas and from there to final destinations on the East Coast. (CalEMA)
