- 1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL Chair, Lou Amell
- 2. <u>PUBLIC COMMENT</u>- (Discussion Only) No action may be taken upon a matter raised under this item of the agenda until the matter itself has been specifically included on an agenda as an item upon which action may be taken. Public comments may be limited to 3 minutes per person at the discretion of the Chair. Comments will not be restricted based on viewpoint.
- <u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES</u> (Discussion/For Possible Action) Chair Amell. This agenda item will discuss whether or not to approve the minutes of the January 9, 2013 NCSC meeting.
- 4. <u>COMMENTS BY THE CHAIRMAN</u> (Discussion Only) Chair Amell. The Chairman will discuss trends at the state, national or global level that may affect the NCSC. Some of these items may be procedural, administrative or policy trends.
- 5. <u>NARROW-BANDING</u>– (Discussion Only) Craig Harrison. This agenda item provides an update on the Nevada Narrow-banding project. Mr. Harrison will talk about the work needed to accomplish the project goals and give a status of the progress of the project and findings to date.

- 9. <u>UPDATE ON PUBLIC SAFETY ANSWERING POINTS (PSAP) LIST</u> (Discussion Only) George Molnar. Mr Molnar will provide an up-to-date list of active PSAPs operating in the state of Nevada, with contact information, for the use and reference of the Committee.
- <u>NCSC MEMBERSHIP CHANGES (RESIGNATIONS/NOMINATIONS)</u> (Discussion Only) – Chair Amell. Chair Amell will discuss recent membership changes pertaining to current member resignations in addition to presenting discussion on current and future nominations.
- 11. DISCUSSION ON THE CLARK COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT (CCSD) STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE (SOP) DEVELOPMENT AND TRAINING PROJECT – (Discussion Only) – Dimitri Theodorou. Mr. Theodorou will present the current status of the CCSD SOP Development and Training Project as it pertains to interoperable communications with internal and external incident responders.
- 12. <u>DISCUSSION AND REVIEW OF NEVADA COMMISSION ON HOMELAND SECURITY</u> <u>PROJECT FUNDING REQUESTS</u> - (Discussion/For Possible Action) – Chair, Lou Amell. Committee will review and discuss funding requests including both de-obligated and reobligated project requests. Committee may act to either disapprove project requests or move approved projects forward in the approval process.

NCHS-65: De-Obligation, Federal Fiscal Year 2010 UASI. Clark County Office of Emergency Management is officially requesting to de-obligate \$122,000 from the Interoperable Communication Coordinator Project and re-obligate the funds to other projects, which include projects below. This is project change request #2. The total de-obligation request is \$122,000.

NCHS-66: Re-Obligation, Clark County School District Standard Operating Procedure Communication Project, Dimitri Theodorou (Clark County Office of Emergency Management) Federal Fiscal Year 2010 UASI. Clark County is requesting to re-obligate \$50,000 to Clark County School District for a standard operating procedure proof of concept to customize interoperable communication generic standard operating procedures to fit Clark County School District. The total request is \$50,000.

NCHS-68: Re-Obligation, Interoperable Communication, Patrick Moers (City of Henderson Police Department) Federal Fiscal Year 2010 UASI. Clark County Office of Emergency Management is requesting to re-obligate \$84,000 to the City of Henderson to purchase radios. The total request is \$84,000.

NCHS-72: Re-Obligation, Nevada Dispatch Interconnect - Communications, Chris Magenheimer (Washoe County Sheriff's Office) Federal Fiscal Year 2012. Washoe County Sheriff's Office is requesting to move funds from equipment to personnel to reimburse for overtime for Washoe County Radio technicians to install equipment. This request includes per diem. This is project change request #1. The total request is \$25,000

NCHS-76: Re-Obligation, Communication/Fusion Center, Captain Meyer (Washoe County Sheriff's Office) Federal Fiscal Year 2010 Re-Obligation Request. Washoe County Sheriff's Office is requesting grant funding for radios for the fusion center. The total cost of this request is \$246,350.50.

NCHS-78: Re-Obligation, Communication Terminal Repeater Project, Jaime Eros (Reno-Tahoe Airport) Federal Fiscal Year 2010 Re-Obligation Request. Reno-Tahoe Airport is requesting grant funds to install bi-directional amplifiers. The total cost of this request is \$380,200.00

NCHS-79: Re-Obligation, Communication, Chief Tanner (Mesquite Police Department) Federal Fiscal Year 2010 Re-Obligation Request. Mesquite Police Department is requesting to purchase radios. The total cost of this request is \$67,608.00
