Dr. Forbes will be presenting the estimated costs of what it would take to equip/supply the NADFSL lab in order to be eligible for possible re-certification by the National Animal Health Laboratory Network (NAHLN) laboratory system. This re-certification would allow the laboratory to test for Foot and Mouth disease and other agroterrorism agents. The Commission may elect to take action on this item. (Discussion/Action).
