- 5. REQUEST TO REALLOCATE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (HSGP) FUNDS (Discussion/For Possible Action) – Chairman Doug Gillespie. NOTE. – This item will address the requests by HSGP project leaders to reallocate funds currently allocated to their projects from the State Homeland Security Program (SHSP), Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) and Metropolitan Medical Response System (MMRS) programs. The requests are:
  - NCHS-37: Training and Exercise (Clark County, Office of Emergency Management-OEM) Ric LaPorte, Program Manager. FFY 2008. Clark County Office of Emergency Management is requesting to de-obligate \$143,942.47 to fund Clark County Fire Department Emergency Operation project and re-program \$66,371 to develop 3 e-learning modules to training Emergency Medical Services (EMS) and Emergency Rooms on the use of mission ready packages.

- NCHS-38: Fusion Center (Washoe County Sheriff's Office) Jerry Baldridge, Program Manager. FFY 2009. Washoe County Sheriff's office is requesting to purchase satellite phones for \$16,818.61, with cost savings from consumable materials and training.
- NCHS-39: Fusion Center (Clark County, Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department) Capt. Al Salinas, Program Manager. FFY 2012. Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department (LVMPD) -Clark County OEM is requesting to move \$173,050 from the equipment category to the planning category to carry out the purchase and integration of COPLINK for the City of Henderson, Boulder City, and Mesquite.
- NCHS-40 Re-obligation: Statewide Tribal Disaster Boxes (Inter Tribal Emergency Response Commission, Inter Tribal Council of Nevada) Terry Bohl, Program Manager. The Inter Tribal Emergency Response Commission is requesting additional funding to purchase 4 communication disaster boxes. Please see budget for full details. This request amount is \$115,017.
- NCHS-41 Re-obligation: Cyber Logging System (Nevada Department of Administration) Christopher Ipson, Program Manager. The Department of Administration is requesting to purchase software and hardware for a cyber logging system which will give the State of Nevada the ability to track and correlate potential cyber intrusions. Please see budget for full details. This request amount is \$99,500.
- NCHS-42 Re-obligation: Statewide Continuity of Operations & Government Sustainment Project (Washoe County Office of Emergency Management) – Aaron Kenneston, Program Manager. Washoe County Emergency Management is requesting funding for Continuity of Operations Planning (COOP) and Continuity of Government (COG) plans throughout Nevada. Please see budget for full details. This request amount is \$175,000.
- NCHS-43 Re-obligation: All-Hazards Regional Multi-Agency Operations and Response (ARMOR) Task Force IED Remediation (Clark County LVMPD) – Jeff Vialard. Clark County Office of Emergency Management is requesting to reallocate FFY 2010 UASI funds in the amount of \$118,000 to ARMOR Task force to purchase equipment. Please see budget for full details.
- NCHS-44 Re-obligation: Emergency Operations Center (Clark County OEM Fire Department) Chief Fernandez Leary, Program Manager. Clark County OEM is requesting to reallocate FFY 2008 UASI funds of \$143,000 to fund the Clark County Fire Department Emergency Operation Center which will be used to purchase equipment, projectors, screens, teleconferencing, displays and work stations. Please see the budget for full details.
- NCHS-45 Re-obligation: Compliance Enforcement Division, Fraud Unit (Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles) Debbie Watson, Program Manager. The Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles is requesting \$88,390 Homeland Security grant funds to purchase equipment. Please see the budget for full details.
