- **4. COMMENTS BY THE CHAIRMAN** (Discussion Only) Chairman, Governor Brian Sandoval.
- 5. REQUEST TO REALLOCATE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (HSGP) FUNDS (Discussion/For Possible Action) Finance Committee Chairman, Doug Gillespie. Note: This item will address specific requests by HSGP project leaders to reallocate funds currently allocated to their projects from the State Homeland Security Program (SHSP), Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) and Metropolitan Medical Response System (MMRS) programs. The requests are as follows:

- NCHS 60: Fusion Center (Nevada Division of Investigation/Department of Public Safety) Ryan Miller. FFY 2011. Nevada Division of Investigation is requesting to purchase an electronic intelligence information management system. This system will increase the ability to manage and track Requests for Information (RFI) Suspicious Activity Reports (SAR), tips, leads, and Intelligence files while enhancing Civil Rights and Privacy Safeguards. The request is to move grant funds from the personnel category and equipment category to equipment and to create a new line item called "Intelligence and Information Management System". The total request is for \$160,500.00.
- NCHS-52: Access Control for Cyber Information (City of Las Vegas) Joseph Santilli, Program Manager. FFY 2011. City of Las Vegas is requesting approval to move funds from planning and organization to equipment due to the fact that the capability assessment and study for phase I of the project was completed at no cost. This funding is requested to begin phase 2 of the project.
- NCHS-53: Access Control for Cyber Information (City of Las Vegas) Joseph Santilli, Program Manager. FFY 2011. City of Las Vegas is requesting approval to move funds from planning and organization to equipment due to the fact that the capability assessment and study for phase I of the project was completed at no cost. This funding is requested to begin phase 2 of the project.
- NCHS-47: Silver Shield (Clark County, Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department LVMPD) Lieutenant Jim Seebok, Program Manager. FFY 2011. LVMPD is requesting to move \$511,640 from various line items. The majority of the funds will come from the contractual line item for site assessment to purchase camera equipment for the Las Vegas Boulevard Camera Project. This project has been programmatically approved by DHS and the Environmental Historical Preservation Screening Memo Process has also been approved.
