FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2018 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (HSGP)**

To all Homeland Security Interested parties:

The Department of Homeland Security has announced the release of the FY 2018 Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP) Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO). The purpose of the FY 2018 HSGP NOFO is to support state, local and tribal efforts to prevent terrorism and other catastrophic events and to prepare the Nation for the threats and hazards that pose the greatest risk to the security of the United States.

Enclosed you will find the complete notice for your review. In FY18, Nevada has received an allocation of \$3,980,000 for the State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) funding stream and \$5,000,000 for the Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) funding stream. Nevada will allocate \$3,781,400 of SHSP to State, Local, and Tribal Nations. Nevada will also allocate \$4,750,000 of the UASI grant funds to the Urban Area. Please refer to the enclosed notice for overall grant eligibility criteria.

Nevada has already opened and closed the grant process. No additional applications or proposals will be accepted for the Federal Fiscal Year 2018 grant process.

Nevada's Five Core Capabilities:

- Intelligence and Information Sharing;
- Cybersecurity;
- Operational Coordination;
- Public Information and Warning; and
- Operational Communications.

National Core Capability Gaps identified in the 2017 National Preparedness Report:

- Cybersecurity;
- Infrastructure Systems;
- Economic Recovery;
- Housing;
- Supply Chain Integrity and Security;
- Natural and Cultural Resources; and
- Risk Management for Protection Programs and Activities.

Cost Share or Match:

- There is no cost share or match requirement for the FY 2018 HSGP.

The deadline for the State of Nevada to submit the FY 2018 HSGP application to the Department of Homeland Security is June 20, 2018. This is a highly compressed timeline, and will require open meetings and specific deliverables as noted below. Thank you!
