Available Funding

- BRIC
 - \$2.3 Billion total
 - \$2.1 Billion for national competition
 - \$2 million set aside for State/Territory/Federally Recognized Tribes
 - \$1 million for C&CB



Available Funding

- FMA
 - \$800 million total
 - \$900 K for Project Scoping per applicant
 - \$300,000 for C&CB activities



Available Funding

- Management Costs
 - 5% of total project cost
 - Paid at 100%
 - See HMA Guidance for allowable management costs



FEDERAL BRIC/FMA TIMELINE

For Applicants (States/Tribes):

Application period opens on September 30, 2022

Submission deadline for applications is 3:00 PM ET (Noon PT) on January 27, 2023.

System-related issues must be addressed by 3:00 PM ET (Noon PT) on January 5, 2023.

Pre-Award Selection Notice: Anticipated in June 2023

Period of Performance:

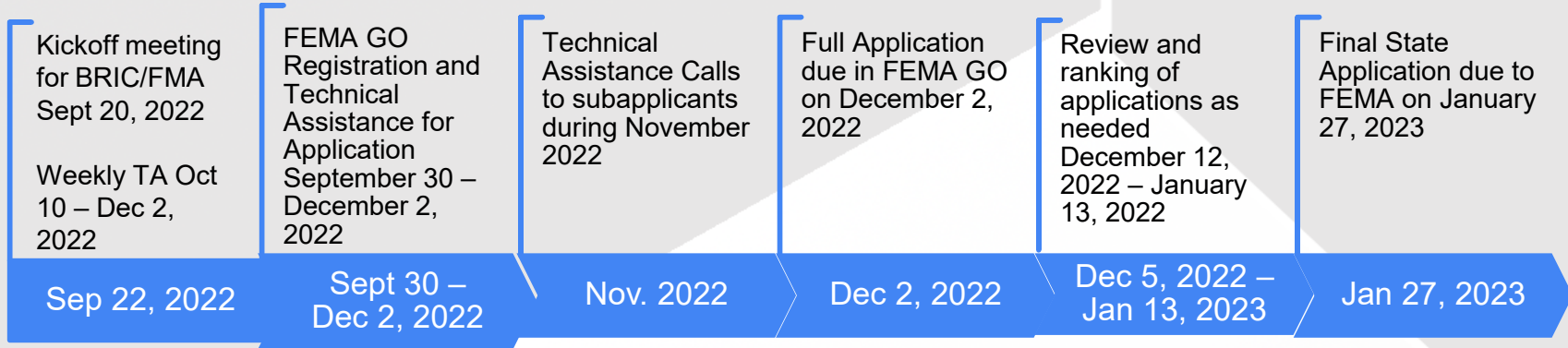
Start Date: When FEMA makes first award to the Recipient (State)

End Date: All projects are 36 months from the date of the first Award EXCEPT for FMA Community Flood Mitigation Projects which are 48 months from the first Award date

****We recommend always requesting the full 36 months for your project to try to avoid extension requests.**

- ✓ Indian Tribal Governments
- ✓ State Agencies
- ✓ Tribal Agencies



HAZARD MITIGATION PROJECT ELIGIBILITY



Expanded Eligibility includes:

- **Project scoping**
- Building code activities
- Pre-award costs
- Additional activities for wildfire and wind implementation (DRRA Section 1205)
- Earthquake early warning (DRRA Section 1233)


