

# PUBLIC ASSISTANCE BULLETIN – FEMA EXTENDS FULL FUNDING FOR COVID-19 EMERGENCY COSTS (3)

### What Will FEMA Fund?

FEMA will fund 100% federal funding to state, local, tribal and territorial governments and certain private nonprofits for eligible emergency actions through July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022.

- Funding can include:
  - o Emergency response costs associated with COVID-19
  - o Reimbursement is specifically for COVID-19 emergency and major disaster declarations through FEMA's Public Assistance program.

After July 1<sup>st</sup> the federal cost share will shift to 90%.

### What are the limits?

- Retroactive 100% federal reimbursement for costs associated with the safe opening and operation of public facilities dating back to Jan. 20, 2020.
