What Will FEMA Fund?

- FEMA will fund eligible work that was conducted from the beginning of the incident period through December 31, 2021, will be reimbursed at a federal cost share of 100 percent.
- Funding can include:
 - o Emergency response costs associated with COVID-19
 - o PPE purchasing and storage
 - o Emergency Protective measures
 - o COVID-19 diagnostic testing
 - o Temporary physical barriers, signage to promote social distancing

What are the limits?

- Must be reasonable and necessary to save lives and protect public health.
- Must be reasonable and necessary to address COVID-19 threats
- Must comply with current policies, Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards
