PUBLIC ASSISTANCE BULLETIN - UPDATED COVID-19 PROGRAMMATIC DEADLINES POLICY **BULLETIN #75 - 04/17/2023**

FEMA has announced that all COVID-19 disaster declaration incident periods will close on May 11th, 2023. Since this update, FEMA has released an updated policy to provide additional guidance to applicants and sub-applicants.

The "Coronavirus COVID-19 Pandemic: Public Assistance Programmatic Deadlines Policy Version 2" policy outlines various deadlines for state, local, tribal, and territorial governments as well as private non-profits. These deadlines will ensure governments and eligible non-profits submit project applications to account for work performed during the past three years and enable FEMA to process funding for all costs that are eligible for federal funding.
