5. EMERGING EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ISSUES :

A. Recovery – Disaster Relief Account – Rick Martin (Discussion Only)

Discussion on the new changes to NRS 353.2705 - 353.2771 the Disaster Relief Account (DRA). Discussing the process for applying; time frame to submit a complete application, being available to testify before Board of Examiners (BOE) and Interim Finance Committee (IFC), the state agencies that review, and the final closeout of application, and applying for extensions, if needed.

B. Statewide Helicopter Frequency – Chris Smith (Discussion Only)

Chief Smith will discuss how Nevada does not have a common radio frequency for first responders to utilize when working with Helicopter Emergency Medical Services (HEMS). This issue and concept was presented to the EMS Advisory Board, and he will discuss how they support the idea.

6. DATA DRIVEN DECISIONS REVIEW OF DISASTER DATA - Rick Martin (Discussion Only)

NDEM is developing an internal working group that will capture duty calls/disasters/emergencies data and information. This information will depict the frequency of type of events, locations, time frames, resources deployed or costs of the event(s), and other significant statistics.

7. UPDATE TO EMERGENCY MANAGER'S WORKSHOP – Paul Burke (Discussion Only). Paul Burke will update the committee on this year's Emergency Manager's Workshop.

Grants – Rick Martin (Discussion Only) Status reports on Emergency Management Program Grant (EMPG) 13 & 14, Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP) 11, 12, 13 & 14, and pre-disaster mitigation 14, etc.

Recovery – Rick Martin (Discussion Only) Provide the status of disaster closeouts for public assistance grants and post-disaster hazard mitigation grants. Introduction of the new State Hazard Mitigation Officer and provide important dates for upcoming classes, trainings, exercises, workshops, etc. that will be available during the second half of the year.

Planning, Training & Exercise – Paul Burke (Discussion Only) **Planning:** Paul will discuss how the planning section has been working on Continuity of Operations (COOP) and Continuity of Government (COG) plans for state agencies and constitutional offices. He will also discuss drought and earthquake plans for Northern and Southern Nevada. **Training:** Paul will discuss how NDEM supports local jurisdictions by providing a mechanism for approval for special events and requested specific trainings. **Exercise:** Paul will list the exercises that will be conducted through the rest of 2014.

Operations – Kelli Baratti (Discussion Only) Provide an update regarding the next generation Emergency Alert System (EAS). Provide an update on First Responder Credentials, the wildfire season and the Intrastate Mutual Aid proposed legislation.
