  - (c) Discuss deficiencies in security with respect to public services, public facilities and infrastructure, if the Commission or committee determines, upon a majority

vote of its members, that the public disclosure of such matters would be likely to compromise, jeopardize or otherwise threaten the safety of the public.

As mandated by the Nevada Open Meeting Law, no action may be taken by the Commission during a closed session. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 239.0115, all information and materials received or prepared by the Commission during a closed meeting pursuant to subsection 2 and all minutes and audiovisual or electronic reproductions of such a meeting are confidential and not subject to inspection by the general public.
