SUBJECT:	National Incident Management System (NIMS) 2024 Quarter 3 Report

Purpose: The Commission receives updated information on the third quarterly report for the period from July to September 2024, which details the statewide adoption and compliance with the National Incident Management System (NIMS), as mandated by Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 239C.310.

Summary: A total of 6,310 students have completed NIMS training facilitated by the Division of Emergency Management (DEM). Of these, 6,142 students engaged in independent study courses, while the remaining 168 students participated in consortium courses, including ICS 300/400 and G/Federal offerings.
