Nye County Department of Emergency Management has 3 full time staff under the direction of Scott Lewis: Administrative Assistant Patrick Lazenby, Logistics Officer Rodd Fernandes and EMS Training Coordinator Mike Klein.

In addition to “standard” EM responsibilities, NCEM provides Administrative, Financial, Logistical and Training support to 7 Volunteer Fire Departments and 3 Volunteer EMS Stations in Amargosa Valley, Beatty, Belmont, Duckwater Shoshone Tribe/Currant Creek, Manhattan, Smoky Valley/Round Mountain and Tonopah.





Nye County in brief:

Nye County is the largest county in Nevada by area and the third largest in the country. Approximately 92% of the county is managed by federal government agencies (DOD, DOE, BLM, NPS, ETC). We have several environmentally sensitive areas, including Ash Meadows National Wildlife Refuge, the White River Valley, several Great Basin sky islands, and part of Death Valley National Park. Nye County is home to the Nevada National Security Site, Tonopah Test Range, Nevada Test & Training Range and Yucca Mountain.

By the numbers:

- 18,159 sq. miles
- 53,883 residents (42,471 in Pahrump)
- 577,000+ visitors annually



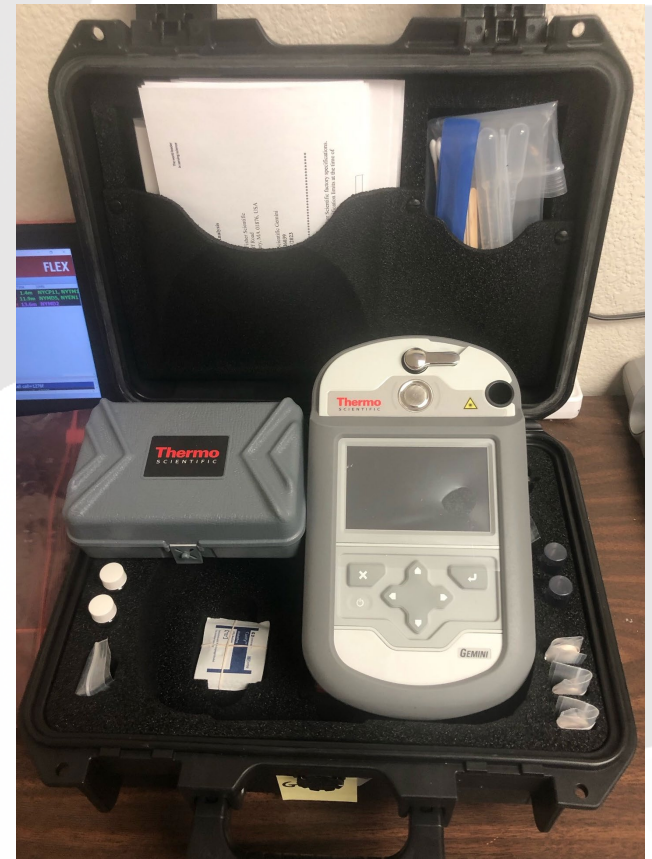
Fiscal Year 2019

- 2 SABRE 5000 Handheld trace detectors for explosives, chemical agents and toxic industrial chemicals or narcotics; \$30,199.50 each, Total: \$60,399.00
- 2 Sabre 5000 consumables kits; \$2,841.00 per kit, \$5,682.00 total
- Training for 8 Operators



Fiscal Year 2020

- 1 Gemini S1 handheld integrated Raman Spectroscopy and Fourier Transform Infrared Spectroscopy (FTIR) analyzer for detection and identification of unknown solid and liquid chemicals and explosives. \$93,662.41 EPWG Funds, \$8,422.59 County Funds, total: \$102,085.00
- Training for 12 Operators scheduled for July 6th, 2023



Fiscal Year 2021

- 2 – 330 gallon single tote foam trailers, \$27,000 each, \$54,000 total
- 10 Pro/Pak Foam Systems, \$950 each, \$9,500 each
- 6 Level A HazMat suits \$2,000 each, \$12,000 total
- Muni Green Plus 3% synthetic fluorine free firefighting foam \$3,900
- Shipping charges total: \$4,350
- Grant total: \$83,750



Fiscal Year 2022 (Pending)

- Physical security upgrades for DEM/EOC: Automated keyless security gate
- Key card entry system for DEM/EOC buildings
- Establish break out conference room for EOC: Conference table & chairs
- 20 ea: PC Monitors, mounting arms and desk lamps
- Wireless ceiling mounted projector for EOC
- Updated radio equipment for ARES/RACES Emergency Communications office
- 3 – 5x multigas detectors with calibration kits
- Total grant request: \$82,060.25
