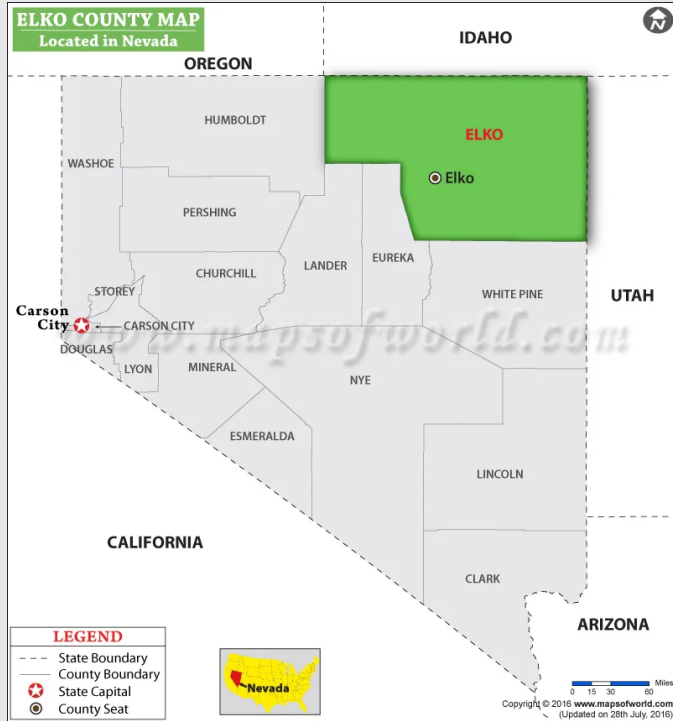
Introduction

County Geogrpahy and Demographics



- Located in Northeastern Nevada, bordering Idaho to the north, Utah to the east, and bordering White Pine, Eureka, Humboldt, and Lander Counties.
- Current Population Estimate: approximately 57,000
- Area: 17,203 square miles
- Cities: Elko, Carlin, Wells, West Wendover
- Unincorporated Areas: Spring Creek, Jackpot
- Tribal: Duck Valley, Elko, Wells, Southfork, Lee

Land Use and Transport Infrastructure



- 72% of the county is public lands managed by the Federal Government
- Amtrak (California Zephyr) stops in Elko
- Union Pacific Freight rail
- Elko Regional Airport has scheduled passenger service
- Interstate 80
- US Route 93, 93 Alternate

- 13 – 4500 psi Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) bottles to support HAZMAT and firefighting operations
- 3 – Zoll X-Series Cardiac Monitor/Defibrillators to align with other EMS agencies in the County and to support HAZMAT entry operations



EPWG 2021

- Support for Elko County Fire Protection District and Regional Emergency Medical Services Operations
- 2 – Stryker Power Pro Gurneys, to support HAZMAT, peak use, and hospital emergency response
- 4 – Five gas monitors, chargers, test equipment, and test gasses
- 1 – Chlorine Institute Emergency Kit (B)
