








### **School Audits**


### 2024 NV School EOP Plans Review Report

- Year 3 of a 5-year cycle of school plan audits
- 50 of 284 plans selected--4 districts, 21 charter, and 22 private schools
- 11 reviewers (NDEM, NDE, and SPCSA), 63% veteran reviewers
- 51 question survey based on NRS plan requirements




## **Overall NRS Concurrence**


Average Concurrence per Year



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
### Top 3 Areas of High Concurrence





#### **Total Schools** Compliance



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
#### 3 Lowest Areas of Concurrence

### **Conclusions**


### **Continued Collaboration and Resource Improvement:**

- NDEM and NDE teams continue the yearly school plans working group
- NDE builds model plan with NDEM collaboration
- NDE and NDEM partner to develop a plan submission checklist with focus on NRS
- NDEM supports School Safety Conference coordination and has an appointed member to the Committee on Statewide School Safety

### **Improvements and Achievements**

- School Plans Review Working Group completed all reviews within a timeline reduction of 50% compared to last year
- Consistent findings prioritize improvement projects to enhance technical assistance
- School audit plans begin to identify strengths in response actions and areas of improvement in recovery actions concerning pupils with access and functional needs, behavioral health concerns, and pupils within LGBTQ and homelessness communities
