There will also be a discussion on who should be responsible for the administration of this certification process, timeframes under which the certification would be maintained, and any recertification process.

INVENTORY AND COORDINATION OF SAR RESOURCES** (Discussion Only) SAR Coordinator Paul Burke will lead a discussion on activities associated with establishing and maintaining a list (inventory) of certified organizations and their resources. The discussion will cover how the list is established, verified, and updated, as well as who has access to the data.

SEARCH AND RESCUE TRAINING** (Discussion/ For Possible Action) The Chairman shall lead a discussion on the establishment of a training calendar, the sharing of training resources and courses, and the establishment of a course review process and POST Certification of courses. There will also be a discussion of either establishing an Instructor register, or listing current instructors and the courses they are able to teach.
