- 1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL Co-Chair, Harriett Vegas.
- 2. PUBLIC COMMENT- (Discussion Only) No action may be taken upon a matter raised under this item of the agenda until the matter itself has been specifically included on the agenda as an item upon which action may be taken. Public comments may be limited to three minutes per person at the discretion of the Co-Chairs. Comments will not be restricted based on viewpoint.

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- **3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES** (Discussion/For Possible Action) Co-Chair, Harriett Vegas. The NTECC will review and discuss the minutes of the February 5, 2024, NTECC meeting. The NTECC will determine whether to approve the meeting minutes.
- 4. NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF THE NTECC TRIBAL CO-CHAIR (Discussion/For Possible Action) - Co-Chair, David Fogerson, DEM/HS. According to NTECC Bylaws, the NTECC members will nominate and vote for a member to serve a two-year term as the NTECC Tribal Co-Chair. Members may nominate and vote upon a new co-chair from the voting members.

- 5. **PUBLIC SAFETY OUTAGE PROGRAM** (Discussion Only) Amber Stringer, NV Energy. Ms. Stringer will explain the NV Energy Natural Disaster Plan and Public Safety Outage Management program to give the NTECC an overview of the process.
- 6. TRIBAL RESILIENCY CONTINUITY PROGRAM (Discussion Only) Lisa Christensen, Washoe Tribe. Ms. Christensen will discuss the tribal resiliency continuity program and its implications to the tribes.
- REVIEW OF BYLAWS (Discussion/For Possible Action) Co-Chair David Fogerson. Chief Fogerson will present current and proposed bylaws with the NTECC to ensure they continue to meet the needs of the Council.
- PALM SPRINGS TRIBAL MEETING REPORT (Discussion Only) Co-Chair David Fogerson. The NTECC will jointly discuss the activities, discussion, and feedback that occurred at the FEMA Region 9 2024 Tribal Partnership Workshop held at the Agua Caliente Rancho Mirage in Rancho Mirage, CA June 25th – 27th, 2024.
- 9. DISCUSSION ON THE STATUS OF THE DEM/HS EFFORTS TO ASSIST OUR TRIBAL NATIONS - (Discussion Only) - Co-Chair David Fogerson. DEM/HS is interested in hearing feedback on the status of the DEM/HS programs as they relate to tribal nation protection, prevention, response, mitigation, and recovery efforts for emergency management, homeland security, and public health preparedness. The NTECC members are encouraged to discuss ways that DEM/HS can improve its efforts to better support their needs. Co-Chair Fogerson will solicit input from individual NTECC members on possible tribal representatives to serve on the NTECC.
- **10.** UPDATE ON TRIBAL HEALTH PREPAREDNESS EFFORTS (Discussion Only) DT Allen, Public Health Preparedness Program. Mr. Allen will update the NTECC on the Division of Public and Behavioral Health's Health Preparedness efforts.
- 11. UPDATE FROM NEVADA DEPARTMENT OF NATIVE AMERICAN AFFAIRS -(Discussion Only) - Stacey Montooth. Ms. Montooth will provide NTECC with an update of Department activities related to the support of Tribal emergency management and public health preparedness.
- 12. UPDATE FROM FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) REGION IX - (Discussion Only) – Josie Burnett, FEMA Regional Tribal Liaison for Nevada. Ms. Burnett will provide the NTECC with an overview of FEMA Region IX allhazards activities and upcoming events. This will include training, Tribal partner engagements, Tribal consultation opportunities, and outreach activities at the regional and Nevada-specific level.
- 13. UPDATES FROM THE DEM/HS TRIBAL LIAISON STAFF (Discussion Only) –Bill Elliot, DEM/HS. The NTECC will be provided an overview of training opportunities, Tribal outreach activities, and updates related to the support of Tribal emergency management and public health preparedness.

- 14. INTRODUCTION OF AGENDA REQUEST ITEM FORM (Discussion Only) Co-Chair David Fogerson will discuss the purpose of the agenda request form as an effort to better engage the Council in the activities of tribal nations relating to public health preparedness and emergency management.
