- 1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL Co-Chair, David Fogerson, Division of Emergency Management and Homeland Security (DEM/HS).
- 2. - 5. UPDATE FROM THE INTER-TRIBAL COUNCIL OF NEVADA (ITCN) (Discussion Only) – Clifford Banuelos, ITCN. Mr. Banuelos will provide the NTECC with an update of ITCN activities to include support of the COVID-19 response and other matters related to support of Tribal emergency management and health clinics.
