- 1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL Co-Chair, Harriett Vegas.
- 2. **PUBLIC COMMENT** (Discussion Only) No action may be taken upon a matter raised under this item of the agenda until the matter itself has been specifically included on the agenda as an item upon which action may be taken. - **3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES** (Discussion/For Possible Action) Co-Chair, Harriett Vegas. The NTECC will review and discuss the minutes of the March 4, 2025, NTECC meeting. The NTECC will determine whether to approve the meeting minutes.
- 4. **TRIBAL NATIONS** (Discussion Only) Co-Chair Brett Compston will provide updates related to legislation, initiatives, personnel, and organizational changes at the Division of Emergency Management.
- 5. UPDATE ON TRIBAL HEALTH PREPAREDNESS EFFORTS (Discussion Only) Doug Dame, Public Health Preparedness Program. Mr. Dame will update the NTECC on the Division of Public and Behavioral Health's Health Preparedness efforts related to

the overall program, staffing, plan review and revision, and a 5-year strategic plan review.

- 6. TRIBAL TRAVEL FUNDING ASSISTANCE (Discussion Only) Aaron Thacker, DEM/HS. The Tribal Coordinator is collaborating with the grants department to explore potential funding opportunities for Nevada's Tribal partners. This funding would support travel for trainings, meetings, and conferences.
- UPDATE FROM THE INTER-TRIBAL COUNCIL OF NEVADA (ITCN) (Discussion Only) – Clifford Banuelos, Tribal-State Environmental Liaison for ITCN. Mr. Banuelos will provide the NTECC with an update of ITCN activities related to the support of Tribal emergency management and public health preparedness.
- 8. UPDATE FROM NEVADA INDIAN COMMISSION (NIC) (Discussion Only) Stacey Montooth. Ms. Montooth will provide NTECC with an update of NIC activities related to the support of Tribal emergency management and public health preparedness.
- 9. UPDATES FROM THE DEM/HS CHIEF RESILIENCE OFFICER (CRO)/STATE HAZARD MITIGATION OFFICER (SHMO) AND TRIBAL STAFF (Discussion Only) Heather Lafferty (CRO/SHMO), Aaron Thacker (Tribal EM), and Kimberly Palma-Ortega (Tribal PHP), will brief the Nevada Tribal Emergency Coordinating Council (NTECC) on recent developments in Tribal outreach and intergovernmental collaboration. Their updates will focus on the ongoing efforts to support Tribal emergency management and public health preparedness across the state. This includes the advancement of initiatives aimed at strengthening partnerships with Tribal Nations, enhancing emergency planning capabilities, and integrating Tribal needs into broader resilience and mitigation strategies. The discussion will also highlight the state's commitment to fostering culturally informed engagement with Tribal communities in alignment with federal resilience and community preparedness goals.
- 10. GRANT STATUS REPORTS (Discussion Only) Shea Slone, DEM/HS. The NTECC will receive quarterly grant reports, which will outline the spending status on Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG), Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP), Nonprofit Security Grant Program (NSGP) and State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program (SLCGP). The NTECC will also be briefed on the status of current and expected grants.
