DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY

RESOLUTION OF THE EUREKA COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS DECLARING A COUNTY-WIDE STATE OF EMERGENCY IN THE COUNTY OF EUREKA INCLUDING AREAS OF BEOWAWE, CRESCENT VALLEY, DIAMOND VALLEY, KOBEH VALLEY, PINE VALLEY, TOWN OF EUREKA, AND THE DUCKWATER (M-103) AND FISH CREEK (M-104) ROADS, DUE TO SEVERE FLOODING CAUSED BY RUNOFF FROM SNOW MELT DUE TO RECENT WEATHER CONDITIONS.

WHEREAS, this severe flooding poses a serious threat to health and safety as well as property of the residents of Eureka County, Nevada; and,

WHEREAS, Eureka County is a political subdivision of the State of Nevada; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners finds that emergency conditions prevail and threats to health, life, safety, and welfare of persons and property due to severe flooding are occurring within Eureka County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Eureka County does hereby resolve that, under the provisions of the Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 414, a State of Emergency does exist due to conditions of peril arising from severe flooding within Eureka County.
