- Post Disaster Grant Program
- Cost share 75/25
- 20% (enhanced state) of total estimated
 Federal public assistance for a disaster
- Administered by the State
- Managed by the FEMA Regional office
- Competitive Grant program

APPLICANTS:

Priority given to declared disaster areas.

Not disaster specific.

Eligible entities:

- State, Tribal, and local governments
- Currently Eligible:
 - Carson County
 - Douglas County
 - Lyon County
 - Washoe County
 - Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe
 - Reno Sparks Indian Colony

HMGP Funding

Planning Requirements

- Applicants must have a FEMA-approved multihazard mitigation plan in order to receive project funding.
- Applicants without an approved multi-hazard mitigation plan are still eligible to receive planning grants.
- Project applications must conform with priorities from the local and state mitigation plans.



- Must be environmentally sound
