TIME OF INCIDENT: 12:00 AM PST on 08MAR23

**INCIDENT DESCRIPTION:** An Atmospheric River will impact Nevada bringing storms over the next couple of weeks with peak rain, snow, and winds throughout the state over several days. **Residual flooding from the storms causing flooding impacting the above counties and tribal** 

nations.

#### **CONDITIONS**

#### **CURRENT SITUATION** (as of 12:00 PM on 19MAR23)

Per the National Weather Service (NWS) Reno, mountain snow and valley showers begin Sunday into Monday morning and a stronger winter storm heads to the region Tuesday and into Wednesday. Elevated flows will continue at some rivers and streams in the region. Lower valleys could see slushy snow accumulation with some runoff or minor flooding. Per the National Weather Service (NWS) Las Vegas, Eastern Lincoln County Meadow Valley Wash near Ursine remains above flood stage and rose Friday afternoon partially due to increased snow melt feeding Meadow Valley Wash above Eagle Valley Reservoir. Minor to moderate flooding is forecast to continue through next week. Precipitation returns Monday through Wednesday with rain and snow levels lowering Tuesday. The Flood Warning has been extended through next Friday, 24MAR23. In addition, the Winter Storm Watch will be upgraded to a Winter Storm Warning.
