INCIDENT DESCRIPTION: An Atmospheric River will impact Nevada starting this evening 13MAR23 with peak rain, snow, and winds throughout Nevada Tuesday 14MAR23. Residual flooding from the storms causing flooding impacting the above counties and tribal nations. **SITREP #:** 8

CONDITIONS

CURRENT SITUATION (as of 11:00 AM on 16MAR23)

Per the National Weather Service (NWS) Reno, blue skies and quiet days continue with a weak winter system happening over the weekend. Warmer temperatures could mean an increased roof avalanche potential. Elevated flows will continue at some rivers and streams in the region. Take advantage of the break to rest and recover as more wind, rain and snow is anticipated for next week Monday night through Wednesday. Best guess for this storm is that it will bring a round of heavy mountain snow and exacerbated snow load impacts. Lower valleys could see slushy snow accumulation or cold rain with some runoff or minor flooding. Periods of strong winds are also a possibility. Per the National Weather Service (NWS) Las Vegas, Eastern Lincoln County Meadow Valley Wash near Ursine shows sharp decline in stream flow; however, minor flooding is forecast to continue into the weekend. Flooding waters are putting pressure on dams in the Spring Valley area of Lincoln County causing erosion of the Echo Canyon dam threatening dam subsidence. Declining flows in Meadow Valley Wash upstream of Echo Canyon Dam could alleviate pressure on emergency spillway and dam.
