**INCIDENT NAME – LOCATION:** 2023 Atmospheric River - 2 #03092023-387 (Region 1 – Southern Nevada – Esmeralda County, Lincoln County, Nye County), (Region 2 – Western Nevada – Carson, Churchill, Douglas, Humboldt, Lyon, Mineral, Storey, Washoe) and (Region 3 – Eastern Nevada – Elko, Eureka, Lander, and White Pine County)

**TIME OF INCIDENT:** 12:00 AM PST on 08MAR23

**INCIDENT DESCRIPTION:** An Atmospheric River will impact Nevada starting this evening 13MAR23 with peak rain, snow, and winds throughout Nevada Tuesday 14MAR23. **Residual flooding from the storms causing flooding impacting the above counties and tribal nations.**

## CONDITIONS

**CURRENT SITUATION** (as of 11:00 AM on 18MAR23)

Per the National Weather Service (NWS) Reno, the last bit of dry, quiet weather is wrapping up as mountain snow and valley showers begin Sunday into Monday morning and a stronger winter storm heads to the region Tuesday and into Wednesday. However, higher-end storm totals are lower due to storm track trending farther South. Elevated flows will continue at some rivers and streams in the region. Lower valleys could see slushy snow accumulation with some runoff or minor flooding. Per the National Weather Service (NWS) Las Vegas, Eastern Lincoln County Meadow Valley Wash near Ursine remains above flood stage and rose Friday afternoon partially due to increased snow melt feeding Meadow Valley Wash above Eagle Valley Reservoir. Minor to moderate flooding is forecast to continue through next week. Precipitation returns Monday through Wednesday. The flood warning has been issued/extended through next Friday, March 24<sup>th</sup>.
