DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners for the County of Washoe, State of Nevada, declared a state of emergency due to imminent severe winter storm and flooding, effective January 6, 2017;

WHEREAS, the City of Sparks in Washoe County, Nevada has declared a state of emergency due to imminent severe winter storm and flooding, effective January 6, 2017;

WHEREAS the University of Nevada, Reno, is located in the County of Washoe, Nevada and is at risk due to imminent severe winter storm and flooding, threatening severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property; and

WHEREAS, the President of the University has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to protect student, employee, and visitor health and safety and to preserve or rehabilitate real and personal property,

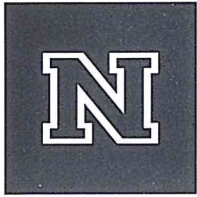
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DECLARED BY THE PREISDENT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NEVADA, RENO

1. That a University state of emergency exists for the University of Nevada, Reno campuses in Washoe County, Nevada.
2. That the state of emergency shall continue until revoked;
3. That this declaration of a University state of emergency shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be provided promptly to the Chair and Vice Chair of the Nevada System of Higher Education Board of Regents and the Chancellor and to the Emergency Manager for Washoe County, Nevada;
4. That this declaration of a University state of emergency activates the comprehensive emergency management and recovery plan of the University of Nevada, Reno; and
5. That this declaration shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
