- 5. <u>UPDATE ON THE CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE COMMITTEE (CIC)</u> (Discussion/For Possible Action) – Chief Bertral Washington, CIC Chair, Clark County Fire Department. Chief Washington will brief the Commission on committee activities including a report on the June 10, 2014 CIC meeting. Discussion may include a recommendation by the CIC to separate cyber-security initiatives from the CIC and move such initiatives to a proposed Cyber Security Committee under the Commission.

UPDATE ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CYBER SECURITY COMMITTEE UNDER THE <u>NEVADA COMMISSION ON HOMELAND SECURITY</u> – (Discussion/For Possible Action) – Christopher Ipsen, Chief Information Security Officer, Nevada Department of Administration. Mr. Ipsen will update the Commission on recent collaborative activities pertaining to the formation of the Cyber Security Committee. The Commission will hear preliminary recommendations for the organizational structure of the Cyber Security Committee and may move to approve the creation of the Cyber Security Committee as a committee under the Commission.
- 7. <u>UPDATE ON THE NEVADA PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS COMMITTEE (NPSCC)</u> (Discussion Only) –Director James Wright, Nevada Department of Public Safety and NPSCC Co-Chair, will provide an overview of the August 21, 2014 NPSCC meeting that may include discussion on the current status of the Request For Proposal (RFP) to hire a State and Local Implementation Grant Program (SLIGP) project manager in addition to the current status of the First Responder Network Authority (FirstNet) consultation process.
- 8. **REVIEW AND UPDATE ON THE FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR (FFY) 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (HSGP) ALLOCATIONS** - (Discussion Only) – Nevada Division of Emergency Management (NDEM) Grant Staff. The NDEM Grant Staff will provide an update to the Commission on the status of the FFY2011-14 HSGP fund allocations including a financial overview and review of grant balances.

Ms. Laffoon will brief the Commission on the Northeast Nevada Citizen Corps Program/CERT in support of the HSGP. This agenda item will highlight the role of this project in Fiscal Year (FY) 2013 in support of building, sustainment, or delivery of core capabilities essential to achieving the National Preparedness Goal (NPG) in a whole-community approach.
