- 4. REVIEW AND UPDATE ON THE FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR (FFY) 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (HSGP) ALLOCATIONS (Discussion Only) – Kelli Anderson. The Committee will hear an update on the status of the FFY2011-14 HSGP fund allocations including a financial overview and review of grant balances.
- 5. REQUEST TO REALLOCATE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (HSGP) FUNDS (Discussion/For Possible Action) – Vice-Chairman, Stacey Giomi. Note: This item will address the requests by HSGP project leaders to reallocate funds currently allocated to their projects from the State Homeland Security Program (SHSP). The requests are as follows:

NCHS-112: City of Las Vegas Fire and Rescue. This request is to move cost savings on personnel and planning to equipment and training for the Metropolitan Medical Response System program. This change request is to procure FirstWatch Community Ambulance Software, CBRNE/Commercial Chemical/Hazard, Southern Nevada Mass Causality Incident Go-Kits, and Heavy Rescue Air Monitoring Equipment for Confined Space Air Monitoring and provide a Disaster Management and Emergency Preparedness Course at UMC Hospital. The total of this change request is \$66,577.52.

NCHS-113 De-Obligation: State of Nevada, Department of Administration, and Enterprise IT Services. This request is a scope change to eliminate a full time position and move additional funding to consultants and contracts and de-obligate \$39,652 from the Federal Fiscal Year 2013 SHSP grant funds for re-obligation. The total cost of this request is \$91,200.

6. DISCUSSION ON THE FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2013 AND 2014 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (HSGP) AND THE FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2014 URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE (UASI) GRANT APPROVED ALLOCATIONS (Discussion/For Possible Action) – Chief Smith, Chief Steinbeck. The Committee will review federal fiscal year 2013 and 2014 final allocations and review FFY 2013 and 2014 funding requests which were not funded.

NCHS-114 Re-Obligation: City of Mesquite. This request is for \$62,985.00 of de-obligated funding for an upgrade to their communication radio system to join the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department's Radio System. The total the total cost of this request is \$62,985.

NCHS-115 Re-Obligation: City of Reno. This request is for up to \$186,900 of de-obligated funding to procure Multi-Gas Monitors. This project may completed in phases. The total cost of this project request is up to \$186,900.
