- 1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL Chairman, Lieutenant Governor Mark Hutchison.
- 2. **PUBLIC COMMENT** (Discussion Only) No action may be taken upon a matter raised under this item of the agenda until the matter itself has been specifically included on an agenda as an item upon which action may be taken. Public comments may be limited to 3 minutes per person at the discretion of the Chair. Comments will not be restricted based on viewpoint.
- **3.** APPROVAL OF MINUTES (Discussion/For Possible Action) Chairman, Lieutenant Governor Hutchison. This agenda item will discuss whether or not to approve the minutes of the September 7, 2016, Cyber Security Committee meeting.
- 4. HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (HSGP) PROCESS OVERVIEW AND UPDATE – (Discussion Only) – Chief Caleb Cage, Division of Emergency Management. Chief Cage will provide an overview of the historical HSGP process, timelines, and requirements of the CSC. Additionally, an update will be provided on the upcoming Federal Fiscal Year 2017 HSGP process and current cyber-related project status.

5. VOTE TO APPROVE THE CYBER SECURITY COMMITTEE TO HOLD A

CLOSED SESSION – (Discussion/For Possible Action) – Chairman, Lieutenant Governor Mark Hutchison. Pursuant to Nevada Revised States (NRS) 239C.140, the Commission and, with the prior approval of the Commission, any committee appointed pursuant to NRS 239C.170 may hold a closed meeting to:

(a) Receive security briefings; (b) Discuss procedures for responding to acts of terrorism and related emergencies; or (c) Discuss deficiencies in security with respect to public services, public facilities and infrastructure, if the Commission or committee determines, upon a majority vote of its members, that the public disclosure of such matters would be likely to compromise, jeopardize, or otherwise threaten the safety of the public.

The committee members will vote on a motion to hold a closed session to receive a cyber-security briefing. The Nevada Commission on Homeland Security at the September 22, 2016, meeting, voted and approved for the CSC to hold a closed session during this specific meeting.

- 6. **PUBLIC COMMENT** (Discussion Only) No action may be taken upon a matter raised under this item of the agenda until the matter itself has been specifically included on an agenda as an item upon which action may be taken. Public comments may be limited to 3 minutes per person at the discretion of the Chair. Comments will not be restricted based on viewpoint.
- 7. CLOSED SESSION: CYBER SECURITY BRIEFING PROVIDED BY THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) – (Discussion Only) – Chairman, Lieutenant Governor Hutchison. This is a closed session pursuant to statutory exemption under Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 239C.140. As mandated by the Nevada Open Meeting Law, no action may be taken by the Commission during a closed session. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 239.0115, all information and materials received or prepared by the Commission during a meeting closed pursuant to subsection 2 and all minutes and audiovisual or electronic reproductions of such a meeting are confidential, not subject to subpoena or discovery, and not subject to inspection by the general public.
